

## Re: Grade 9 Orientation Day

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to St. Paul's High School!

**Arrival:** Students are to be dropped-off at the Multiplex Entrance (east side of the School on Holland Blvd.) beginning at 8:00 am. Do **not** drop off your child at the front entrance off Grant Ave.

## **Important Notes:**

- Dress Code III: Relaxed Dress Code is in effect on Orientation Day. Students do <u>not</u> need to wear Dress Code I (suits) or Dress Code II (golf shirts). Dress should be casual but neat. Clothing must not be torn, frayed, dirty, or have holes. No pajama pants. No clothing with objectionable images or anything that would conflict with the School's Catholic values.
- Students will receive textbooks on this Orientation Day. They should bring a **backpack** to carry their books.
- Students must bring a **pen** for writing their names in their textbooks.
- Students will be assigned a locker and will receive a **lock** from the School. Use of any other locks is <u>not</u> permitted.
- The School will provide lunch for each student. Please communicate **dietary needs** directly to me (<u>cmartinez@stpauls.mb.ca</u>) by Tuesday, September 3. Students can bring their own reusable water bottle for use throughout the day.
