# Ticket & registration info

- Tickets go on sale **April 14**
  - \$90 / person for dinner
  - \$70 / person for Safe Grad (Class of 2026 and guests each pay \$70)
- Crusader Raffle in November reduced cost of tickets – thank you!
- Grad Information Package on school website
- Dinner & Safe Grad registration forms and payment **due May 29**
  - Options to pay by credit card online, cheque / cash in person
  - Registration forms must be filled out online
  - Recommend fill out forms on laptop / desktop rather than phone
  - **Unable to make changes to dietary restrictions, meal on day of event**

# Safe Grad check-in process

- **Check in for Safe Grad:** 9:30 p.m. in lobby
  - Parents / guardians **MUST** check in sons and dates – no exceptions
- **Safe Grad:** 9:30 p.m. – 2 a.m.
  - Class of 2026 graduates plus guests & parent volunteers only
  - Not necessary to bring a guest or stay till the end
  - Unable to come and go from premises during Safe Grad
- **No phones in Safe Grad**
  - Will be handed in during Safe Grad check in and returned at check out
  - Applies to grads **and** guests
- **Formal attire for entire evening:**
  - Not able to change into casual clothes; will be flip flops available for girls

# Safe Grad activities

- Complimentary food – pizza, chips, candy and donuts
- Complimentary water and pop
- Alcohol for purchase (purchase tickets to exchange at bars)
- Only grads and guests 18+ wearing “Age Verified” wristbands allowed to purchase and consume alcohol at Safe Grad
- As ID may be in their phone case, suggest have cash, card or purchase tickets at dinner for Safe Grad so don't have to worry about ticket purchasing
- Safe Grad will be a fun, safe evening for grads and their guests

# Everyone must bring government-issued ID

- Whether you are 18 or younger, whether you plan to drink alcohol or not
- **Includes grads & guests – no exceptions**
- Required **ONLY** for Safe Grad, not dinner
- Wristbands given to those who are 18 to purchase alcohol
- Will be sent home to retrieve ID if you or guests doesn't bring it with you
- Copies of ID **NOT** accepted

# Identification

When asked, you must show one of the following pieces of valid government-issued identification (ID):

- DRIVER'S LICENCE ISSUED IN MANITOBA OR ANOTHER JURISDICTION
- MANITOBA IDENTIFICATION CARD
- SECURE CERTIFICATE OF INDIAN STATUS
- MANITOBA MÉTIS FEDERATION CITIZENSHIP CARD
- PASSPORT
- CANADIAN ARMED FORCES IDENTIFICATION CARD
- FIREARMS POSSESSION AND ACQUISITION LICENCE
- NEXUS CARD

Alternatively, you must show two forms of valid government-issued ID, one of which must be photo ID. Examples include:

- ▶ Certificate of Indian Status
- ▶ Certificate of Canadian Citizenship
- ▶ Permanent Resident Card



# Safe Grad check-out process

- **Safe Grad pick at 2 a.m.**
  - Grads and their guests **MUST** be picked up **no later than 2:30 a.m.**
- Grads and guests must be picked up by responsible adult identified on driver release form as part of registration
  - Responsible adult / driver can be changed at check in (must sign form)
  - Responsible adult / driver **MUST** bring valid government-issued photo ID, **NOT** copies, to verify identify – **no exceptions**
  - Parent volunteers can be the responsible adult / driver at check out if on the later evening volunteer shift
