



Teacher Professional Conduct Review Process

St. Paul's High School encourages that concerns about a teacher or school clinician will normally be raised first through the school's established communication and resolution pathways, where appropriate, so the matter can be understood in context and addressed promptly and fairly.

Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning has established an independent process for concerns related to professional conduct or competence. As required, the school includes the following notice:
